Even if your child does not wish to take school meals, if you are eligible, the school will receive funding called Pupil Premium which will be used to offer your child additional support and opportunities in school.

If your child is eligible it means they can enjoy delicious, healthy meals without the cost or fuss of making packed lunches. Meat and vegetarian options are available, and we can also cater for children who have other dietary requirements. This includes religious and cultural, as well as allergy and intolerance dietary requirements.

Many children at school will be accessing free school meals and benefiting from Pupil Premium, and your child may also be eligible. Make sure you are not missing out. You only need to complete the Surrey Pupil Premium Application Form* once for us to continually check if you are entitled.
